Outcomes:

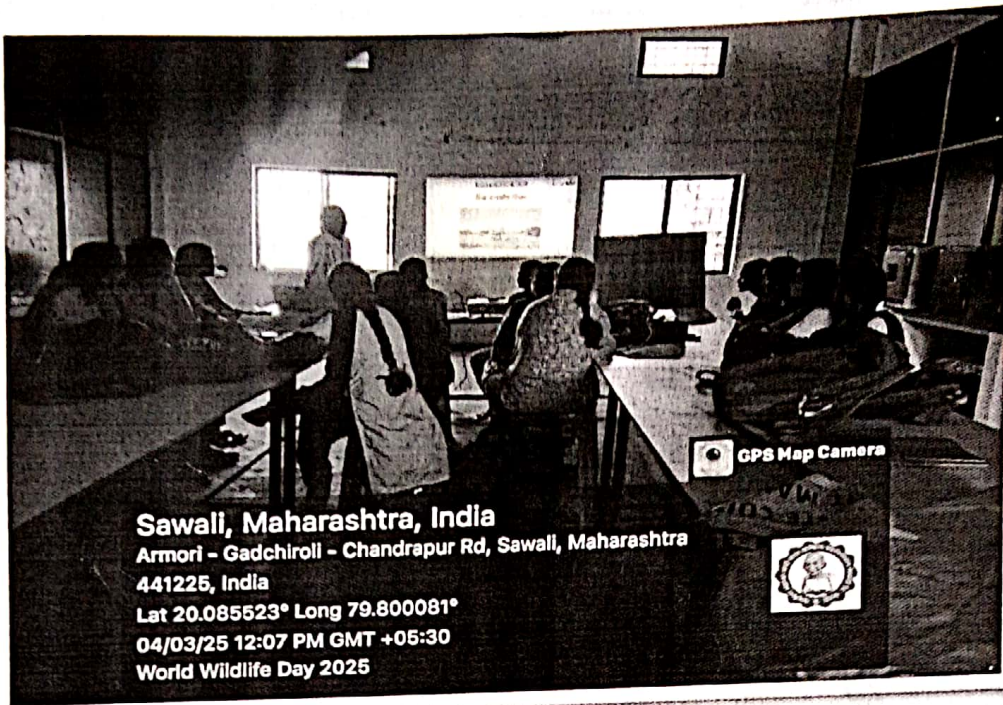
- Enhanced awareness among students about the importance of wildlife conservation.

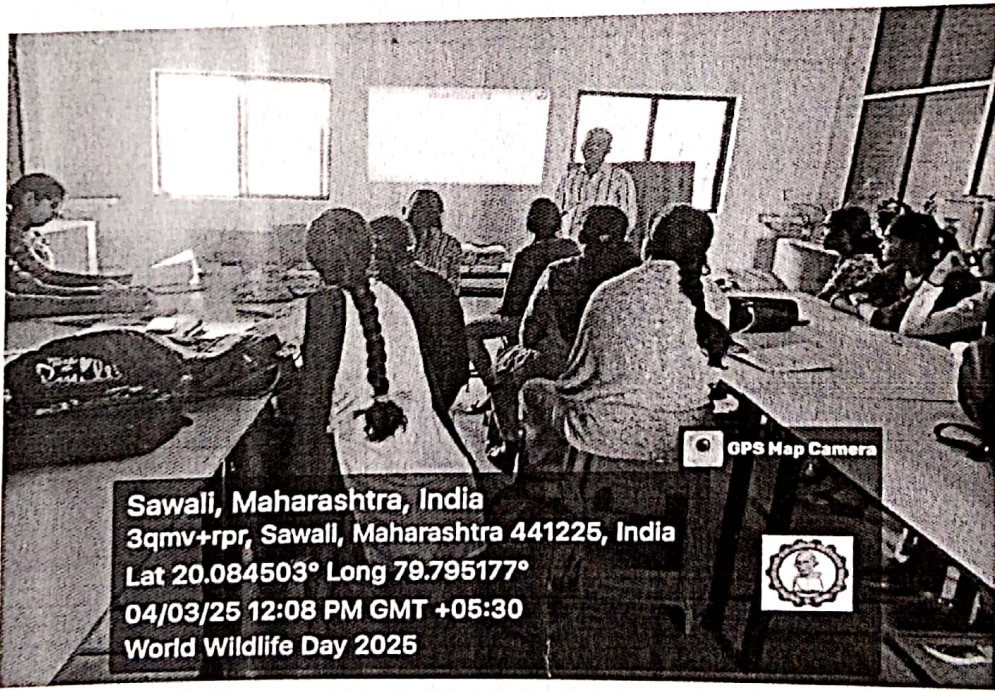
