Impact of the Study Tour:

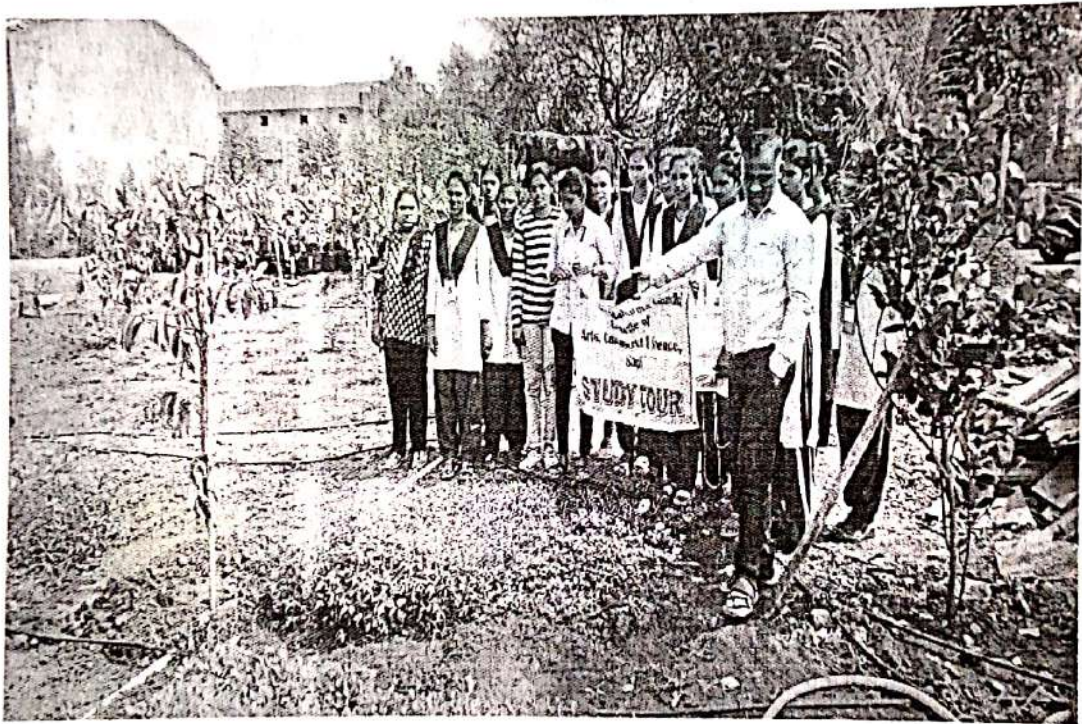
- Students gained practical exposure to integrated farming systems.

Conclusion:

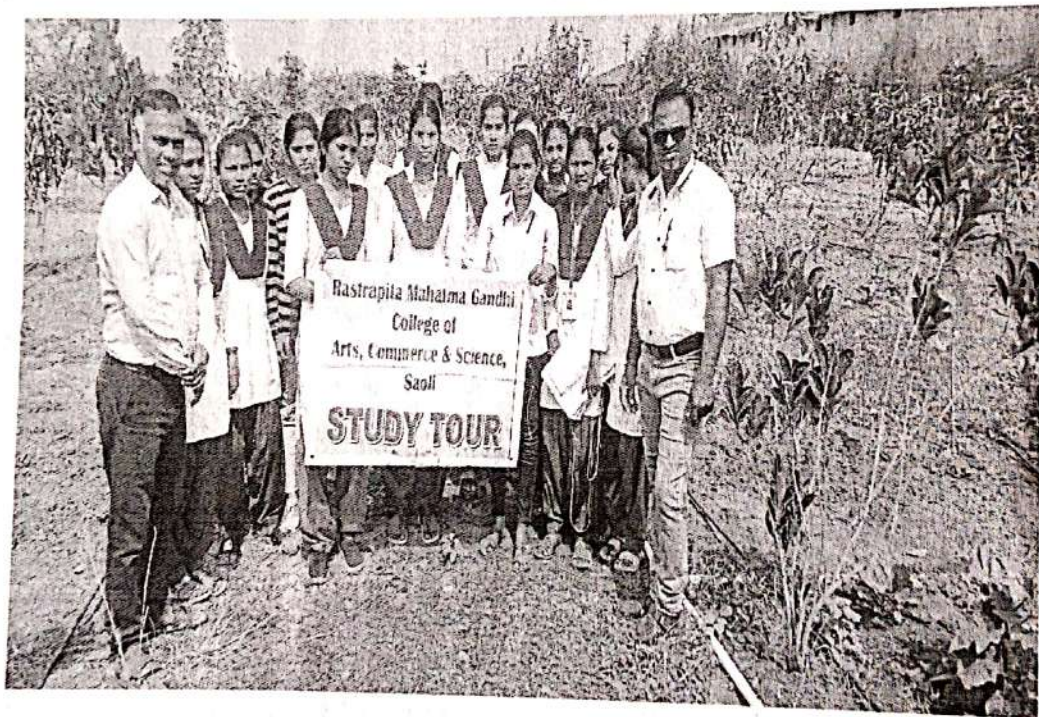
